QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum of 2 years supervisory experience

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conducts resident health assessments with new residents within 30 days of their move-in date.
- Oversees or provides, in conjunction with the family, coordination with resident physicians and other health care providers.
- Participates in the pre move-in resident assessment process.
- Assists the Health Services Director with conducting and/or coordinating staff in-services and training, as required.
- Working knowledge of and ability to conform to applicable laws, rules and regulations.
- Responds appropriately to safety hazards, fire drills and other emergency situations.

- All other duties as assigned.
